Visual Field Exam

We strive to provide cutting edge technology to provide better care for our patients. Our highly sophisticated computerized Visual Field analyzer allows us to provide a more thorough analysis of your visual function. The Visual Field analyzer electronically measures retinal function and sensitivity to light. This measurement can assist us in the early detection of many disorders such as glaucoma, brain tumors, cerebral vascular disease, as well as toxicity to various medications.

We strongly recommend that all of our patients receive the screening version of this exam, it is especially important for those who have:

- Headaches
- Family history of glaucoma
- Previous high or high-normal Intraocular pressure readings
- History of vascular or circulatory disease (high blood pressure, diabetes, etc.)
- A requirement by the DMV for this screening

There is an additional charge of \$20.00 for the routine screening exam. This computerized exam is different from the gross Visual Field by confrontation covered by most Insurance plans. If a defect is found on the screening, further more complex visual field may be indicated and may be covered by major medical insurance.
